Student Enrollment, Class Rosters, and Grading

Class rosters, student photos and emails, PERM processing, low grade notices/academic advisories, and grading are all accessed on the portal (portal.claremontmckenna.edu) under the Faculty tab.

Portal accounts are created for all instructors except student instructors. Student instructors should communicate all needs to Randy Town. Instructions and tutorials for using the portal are available in the Portal Resources portion of the Faculty Resources web page (www.cmc.edu/registrar/faculty-portal-instructions).

Please note that portal passwords expire every year. Use the <u>self-service link</u> (mypassword.claremontmckenna.edu) provided by ITS to update your password as needed.

Communication with Students

If you teach an online, asynchronous, or arranged class (a class that is not listed with a firm meeting time - e.g., MW 10-11a.m.) you will need to contact your students directly and provide course information and zoom links, as needed.

It is important to notify your students via the portal if their attendance is falling behind during the semester (low grade notice/academic advisory).
